ORDINANCE

Totally Opt Out of IOH Length and Weight Limit

Whereas, 2013 Wis. CT 377 UNDER Sec. 348.77 (19) (b) 5.a. provides that a municipality or county may authorize implements of husbandry as defined in Sec. 340.01 (24) and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Sec. 340.01 (10) of Wis. Statutes to exceed any statutory length and weight limits imposed by the Chapter 348 of the Wis. Statutes,

Now, therefore, BE IT HEREBY ORDIANED by the Town Board of Shullsburg, of Lafayette County, that pursuant to Sec. 348.27 (19)(b) 5.a. of Wis. Statues, implements of husbandry and agricultural vehicles as defined by Chapter 340 of Wis. Statutes may exceed any length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wis. Statutes.

Further, BE IT HEREBY ORDIANED that his ordinance shall remain in effect until rescinded by further action by the board.

Further, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that a copy of this ordinance shall be provided to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to be posted on the state DOT website.
