





# Driving a Median U-Turn intersection

Right turns from US 53 and right turns from County B can still be made directly at the existing US 53 / County B intersection.

However, left turns from US 53 and left turns and crossing movements from County B need to be made indirectly by using one of the two median u-turns, each located on US 53 about 800 feet either side of County B.



## How to drive a Median U-Turn

1. Driving on US 53, merge into the left turn lane to make a left turn onto County B.
2. Driving on County B, stop as you reach US 53. Look left for a safe gap in traffic. Turn right from County B into the left (turn lane) of US 53.
3. Stop or yield as indicated when you reach the far lanes of US 53. Look to your right for a safe gap in traffic. Turn left and enter the left lane of US 53 if continuing on US 53 increase your speed as you merge.
4. If turning onto County B, enter the right lane of US 53.
5. Look for a safe gap in the right lane of US 53, signal, and change lanes.

## Some rules to remember

- » Always look for safe gaps in US 53 traffic before entering or changing lanes.
- » Always use your turn signal to indicate your intention.
- » Watch for directional signs for US 53 and County B to help you navigate.
