


Issue and goals – Late Title Report

- To improve services for our customers and increase the efficiency of resource the DMV allows dealers and their agents to process title work
 - The DMV creates a monthly report for inspectors that highlights third parties that have not met statuary requirement for processing titles
 - This ensures accountability to state law that requires dealers process titles within 7 business days.
- **CR** Creating this report took 7 to 9 hours each month
 - Manual manipulation and keying of data
 - Data from several different sources in different formats
- Received a project goals
 - Decrease the amount of time needed to complete this report



Results and next steps – Late Title Report

- As a result of changes made to incoming data
 - Decreased the monthly time commitment to 10 minutes.
 - Output Decreased complexity has led to easier training
 - Reduction in keying data reduces chances of error
- Rext steps
 - Cross train additional staff on new process to ensure business continuity
 - Add financial information



Lessons learned

When Lean projects focus on processes that happen only a few times a year they take longer

- Real to work with outside entities
- Conductor Don't confuse long-term processes with inefficiency
