# Overview: E-Credential Pilot

- ▶ Drivers and companies can carry electronic credentials
- ▶ Concept to move away from paper credentials
- ▶ Carriers can opt-in at any time during pilot
- ▶ Any number of drivers from a carrier can be involved
- ▶ Carriers/drivers can carry any form of electronic credential
- ▶ Paper credentials required during the pilot



# Timeline: E-Credential Pilot

- ▶ April – September 2016: On-road pilot program
  - Potential pilot extension beyond 2016
- ▶ Survey: May, August & October 2016
  - Carriers
  - Drivers
  - Law enforcement
  - State administrators
- ▶ January 2017: Wisconsin DOT issues initial findings



# Goals of E-Credential Pilot:

- ▶ Short-term on-road pilot goals
  - Review as many E-C alternatives as possible
  - Utilize carrier ingenuity and creativity
  - Familiarize law enforcement with electronic credentials
  - Determine potential issues/problems
  
- ▶ Long-term
  - Save time for carriers, drivers and law enforcement
  - More up-to-date in-cab credentials



# States Involved:

- ▶ Wisconsin (project lead)
- ▶ Alabama
- ▶ Iowa
- ▶ Michigan
- ▶ Minnesota
- ▶ Virginia
- ▶ Illinois (partial involvement)



# Paperwork/Credentials Included:

- ▶ IRP cab card, or intrastate vehicle certificate of registration
- ▶ Trailer vehicle certificate of registration
- ▶ IFTA license
- ▶ Lease agreement, if lessee is providing IFTA or IRP
- ▶ Authority (for hire) documents, if for hire
- ▶ Certificate of insurance



## Paperwork/Credentials Included (continued):

- ▶ Hazmat registration certificate
- ▶ Driver hours of service records
  - Note: Copies of paper logs are not required if carrier uses electronic logging device meeting federal performance and design standards, such as PeopleNet, Qualcomm, Webtech, or other such system.
- ▶ Non-hazmat bills of lading
- ▶ Evidence of UCR registration
  - at carrier discretion, not required
- ▶ HVUT evidence of payment
  - at carrier discretion, not required



# Paperwork/Credentials Excluded:

- ▶ CDL: Commercial Drivers License
- ▶ Fed-Med: Federal Medical Examiners Certificate
- ▶ Hazmat shipping papers, and related documents
- ▶ Hazardous Materials Guidebook
- ▶ Emergency Response Guidebook
- ▶ FMCSA Regulations Handbook
- ▶ Canadian Operating Authority
- ▶ Any other paperwork not listed as “included” in the previous section

  - E-mail to law enforcement
- ▶ Website (URL)
