


In the U.S. 6,000 teens die every year in car crashes. That's an average of 16 a day! Don't let your friends be one of the 16.

## wear your seatbelt

We all know that seat belts save lives, yet two-thirds of teens who die in car crashes are not buckled up. Car crashes are the #1 killer of teens in the U.S. Sixteen teens die in car crashes every day, and these deaths are preventable. One click of your seat belt can reduce your chance of death or injury in a crash by almost 50%. Think about it. Make a rule that all of your friends have to wear their seat belt when they ride in your car. It will help get them in the habit and could save their lives someday.

Twice as many teen guys die in car wrecks than teen girls. Coincidence? Not really, 18% of teen guys say they never wear their seat belts compared to 10% of teen girls. So guys, wear your seat belt, it's just stupid not to.



Seat belts not only save lives, they also save money. Seat belts save about \$50 billion dollars per year in medical costs! Not to mention if you get pulled over and you aren't wearing your seat belt you can get a ticket and extension of your GDL restrictions.

## drive the speed limit



Speaking of tickets, speeding tickets can cost big bucks!

Plus these tickets stay on your driving record for five years. According to the

National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the economic cost of speeding is \$40 billion dollars per year. That's \$1,281 per second!

Speeding is the cause of nearly 40% of all fatal teen crashes. If you or your friend cut the wheel too hard at high speeds, the car could flip, causing serious injuries or fatalities. SUV's, in particular, handle much more sensitively at high speeds.



Speeding is also the #1 cause of single car crashes. Not enough drivers realize the consequence of speeding is much more than just a ticket and points off your license. Speeding can cost you your life.

It's time we learn speeding reduces steering ability, extends stopping distance and increases possibility of death. For every 10 mph you travel over 50 mph the chance of serious injury doubles! It's sad when we can't do the basics to stay safe on the roads.
