

# Summary of Public Comments on the Draft STIP

WisDOT did not receive any requests to hold a public hearing. A summary of the one comment WisDOT received within the 30 day comment period and minor revisions of the draft STIP are included below.

Mr. Bill Wheeler, Community Planner for the Federal Transit Administration, Division 5, Chicago IL; as part of FTA's review of the WisDOT Draft STIP submitted a comment via email on December 1, 2016. Mr. Wheeler requested "WisDOT add the local funds and list the source(s) ... under each of the programs for which WisDOT will apply directly to FTA (Section 5310, 5311, 5329, others?)". WisDOT's Transit Section staff in the Bureau of Transit, Local Roads, Railroads and Harbors revised the funding table and worked with Mr. Wheeler for concurrence of these revisions. The revised funding table with local funding included is in the Transit section (Section 5) of the final STIP.

Other revisions of the draft STIP involved the Public Law citation of *Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act)*. The *FAST Act* Public Law citation was updated to P.L. 114-357 as per the final *Statewide and Nonmetropolitan Transportation Planning; Metropolitan Transportation Planning; Final Rule* published May 27, 2016. These P.L. 114-357 revisions were made within the Introduction, Certification, and Public Involvement sections.
