

Tribal Elderly Transportation Assistance Program

- Statutory reference: s. 85.215, Wis. Stats.
- State-funded program which began in 2009
- Eligible applicants: Federally recognized Tribes in Wisconsin
- Annual application cycle: Applications are due December 31 of each year

Wisconsin's Federally-recognized Tribes determine the distribution of these grant funds. At present, all eleven Tribes receive an equal share of available annual funds.

Eligible Expenditures:

- Directly provide service to tribal elderly
- Purchase transportation service from any public or private organization
- Directly reimburse elderly passengers for their use of transportation service
- Volunteer driver escort reimbursement
- Reimburse elderly persons for use of their personal means of transportation under certain conditions
- Perform or purchase planning or management studies on transportation
- Coordinate transportation services
- Perform or purchase in-service training relating to transportation service
- Co-payments (fares or donations)
