

## Bridge width associated with Implements of Husbandry Policy

## <u>Definition of "Implements of Husbandry (IOH)"</u>

Vehicle used exclusively in the conduct of agricultural operations.

Local Public Agency (LPA) must justify IOH need. LPA (or agent) must submit a justification that contains:

- 1) Number of IOH veh (day, season, year)
- 2) Width of IOH veh
- 3) ADT
- 4) Past crash history with a discussion of existing geometric configuration as it relates to IOH
- Change Management is required if a funding increase becomes a necessary Structure width in excess of incoming facility, and in excess of Trans 214 and 215 minimums will typically not be approved.
  - Included discussion on how existing structure width is attributable to crashes or how crashes have been noted to have been related to IOH will be a plus
  - Region will verify the justification and recommend approval. Bureau of Project Development (BPD) will review the request and recommendation, and either confirm or deny
  - If BPD approves the then we can authorize construction of larger size structure, either as listed in TRANS 214 or 215, or as meets existing incoming roadway
- State Statutes 346. Rules of the Road requires oncoming vehicle must yield 50% of the roadway
  to vehicle in opposing lane. Therefore, IOH need generally cannot be more than 50% of the
