




WisDOT - Improvement Program NW Region 2016 - 2021



Improvement Concept Definitions
 New Bridge or Bridge Replacement represents several improvement types:
 1) New bridge creating a new grade separation or structure
 2) A bridge replacing an existing crossing but not necessarily in the same place
 3) A bridge replacing an existing crossing to increase system capacity
 4) Bridge elimination
 Bridge Rehabilitation represents several improvement types:
 1) Bridge rehabilitation. Usually bridge deck overlay or deck replacement
 2) Minor overlay on bridge decks, bridge painting, or other maintenance
 Miscellaneous - Not a roadway or bridge project. Usually a pedestrian or safety focus
 Reconstruction - Replace most of the roadway and upgrade to current design standards
 Reconditioning - Change intersection or roadway to improve safety and/or operation
 Resurfacing - Add pavement material to existing pavement, includes safety improvements
 Pavement replacement - Replace pavement, and usually no geometric changes
 Roadway maintenance - Maintenance to address problem areas or routine preservation
 Including State Highway Rehabilitation Maintenance (SHRM)
