

Location

Coloma – Redgranite
(N. Madison St. – STH 22)
Waushara County
13.5 miles



Project information

- ▶ Project needs:
 - Pavement cracking and rutting
 - The guardrail requires replacement
 - Safety concerns – motorists crossing centerline and run-off-the-road crashes
- ▶ The purpose of this project is to improve the deteriorated pavement and extend the pavement structure life



Proposed improvements

- ▶ Resurface the roadway
- ▶ Install new guardrail
- ▶ Tree clearing within right of way
- ▶ Widen paved shoulders for bicycle accommodations
- ▶ Minor intersection improvements
 - Slater Street
 - County B
 - County II



Proposed improvements

- ▶ Between 2007 and 2011 there were 35 run-off-the-road crashes. Part of the proposed safety improvements include installing centerline rumble strips and pavement safety edge.



Traffic Impacts

- ▶ Motorists can expect to encounter flagging operations and brief delays
- ▶ The Ice Age trail will remain open during construction. Trail users may encounter short delays.



Next steps

- ▶ Continue with design and plan preparation work
- ▶ Complete agency coordination
- ▶ Complete project plans – August 1, 2017
- ▶ Construction currently scheduled – summer 2018
