## **Welcome!**

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide an overview and gather information for the proposed reconstruction of WIS 57 from Randall Avenue in the city of De Pere to the village of Allouez northern village limit, just north of Marine Street.

### **A short project presentation will be given at 5:10 p.m.**

This meeting is an information gathering meeting that is an open forum. It is an opportunity for you to communicate with project design staff and relate information and ideas that may be beneficial to the designers as they work through the design process to improve this corridor. Verbal or written comments are encouraged. If you are aware of historic buildings, septic systems, drain tiles, underground sprinklers, drainage problems, or other specific information such as safety concerns or thoughts on pedestrian and bicycle accommodations along the corridor, please share this with design staff.

## **Description of Projects**

The proposed improvement includes:

### ***WIS 57 (Broadway Street) from Randall Avenue to north city limits, city of De Pere (ID 4085-39-00)***

WIS 57 will be reconstructed from Randall Avenue in the city of De Pere to the northern city limit in the city of De Pere, located near the Fox Point Boat Launch. The approximate length of the project is 0.4 miles.

### ***WIS 57 (Riverside Drive) from south village Limits to north village limits, village of Allouez (ID 4085-38-00)***

WIS 57 will be reconstructed from the south village limit, located near the Fox Point Boat Launch, to the north village limit in the village of Allouez. The approximate length of the project is 3.0 miles.

Work under these projects includes:

- replacement of underlying utilities (water and sanitary sewer) by the municipalities
- reconstruction of the existing pavement, curb and gutter, and sidewalk
- replacement of the existing storm sewer system along the entire project
- intersection improvements

No significant changes in profile or alignment are planned for this project. Additional right-of-way is anticipated. These projects may be constructed concurrently.

### **Proposed Schedule**

- Alternatives Development – Spring 2013
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Public Meeting – Fall 2013
- Preliminary Design – Winter/Spring 2014
- Complete Environmental Report – Fall 2014
- Begin Final Design – Winter 2015
- Real Estate Needs Identified – 2016
- Utility Relocations – 2017
- Construction – 2018
