


## Structure Pattern

There are several structural retaining walls which will be implemented on the WIS 57 corridor. The pattern on these structures is intended to be consistent along the corridor, so one pattern will be used for all structures along the corridor. The Brick Pattern (common on US 41) and the New England Drystack pattern (similar to nearby Allouez Avenue over the East River) are the two structure patterns under consideration. **You have the opportunity to decide which of the following structure patterns you would like to see along WIS 57. 


