The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has scheduled a public involvement meeting to present and discuss the proposed improvement alternatives for the WIS 32 and WIS 165 intersection, in Kenosha County.

The meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday, September 22, 2015** at the **Pleasant Prairie Renaissance School** at **10450 72nd Ave, Pleasant Prairie, WI 53158**. The meeting will follow an open house format.

You may stop in anytime between 5 to 7 pm to review the proposed alternatives and provide comments to WisDOT staff regarding the project. All persons having an interest in the project are encouraged to attend.

Purpose and Need:

The existing two-way stop control at the intersection of WIS 32 and WIS 165 does not sufficiently handle the traffic flow resulting in long delays for the motoring public.


Proposed Improvements:

Intersection types to be considered

- Signal Alternative Improvements
- Roundabout Alternative

Factors reviewed with each alternative included real estate impacts, environmental impacts, access, drainage and construction costs.
