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	<p>My name is Sue Lassig-Venner. I wish to make a statement concerning my view on constructing what you like to refer to as the North/South Corridor. We never approved the work already done in preparation to tie into your hoped for eventual N/S road through the marsh and we want you to cease any further incursion there.</p> <p>You continue to try to force the N/S corridor on us even after the mandate saying we don't want it. This marsh is an ecological marvel few communities are fortunate enough to have. It's also a Natural Laboratory for our elementary and high school and students of our 3 colleges to conduct natural science experiments.</p> <p>What the marsh does for the quality of our environment is incalculable.</p> <p>La Crosse is a narrow strip of land approximately 3 miles wide from bluff to river. We already have 3 major multi-lane arteries to carry traffic. The BIG TRAFFIC PROBLEM you refer to lasts about an hour in both the morning and late afternoon. Visitors from bigger cities laugh when you refer to this as being a morning or evening RUSH HOUR. Only so much can be done with the area we live in and people can plan ahead. Leave home a little earlier or work a little later; 15 minutes would make a huge difference. If they have flexible work schedules they could shave 15 minutes off their lunch hour and arrive 15 minutes later or leave work 15 minutes earlier or just come earlier or later and leave later or earlier. Fewer signal lights for stop and go traffic with some by-passes would be another solution. Count the signals between La Crosse St. and Woodmans. Maybe a frontage road in the mall area would be a good idea.</p> <p>This is not a north side issue nor is it a county issue either. It is a La Crosse issue. We La Crosse citizens will bear the brunt ecologically, socially and financially. Trying to make this a county-wide issue is just another ruse to force it on us. As this great resource is continued to be filled-in, flood waters will be displaced, causing damage to our properties. Who is going to pay for the damage? The DOT? I would say NOT. The DNR? Same answer. In the end, we are the losers. These listening/information meetings don't seem to be working.
