Coulee Region Transportation Study meetings scheduled for November

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation Southwest Region office in La Crosse has scheduled the fourth round of public involvement meetings to gather input on the Coulee Region Transportation Study. The meetings will be held:

The meetings will provide a review of study activities and next steps in the Planning and Environment Linkages (PEL) process to examine transportation in the area. The study process is currently examining a range of strategy packages developed through public input. The next steps involve elimination of the packages that do not meet the objectives established earlier in the study process, followed by further refinement of the packages that remain.

The meetings are open to the public to review study materials, ask questions, and provide comments. WisDOT project staff will be available to discuss and gather input.

Additional meetings will be held in January. Completion of the PEL report is expected in 2016. There are no plans or construction projects scheduled at this time. Construction of any improvements recommended cannot be considered until the PEL and subsequent environmental impact study are completed.
