

To file a Wisconsin Driver Report of Crash, it must meet the legal description of a motor vehicle crash. By definition, a motor vehicle crash must involve at least one motor vehicle in transport.

If your car was parked and un-occupied when it was damaged **you must be able to identify** the driver or the owner of the moving vehicle to submit a crash report online.

To identify the driver you will need to provide:

Information on the other driver including his/her:

- . Full name
- . Complete address
- . Wisconsin driver's license number or date of birth

Or:

Information on the other vehicle including the:

- . Full name of owner
- . Complete address of owner
- . License plate number or identification number of vehicle
- . Make of vehicle
- . Year of vehicle

You may need to contact your insurance agent for assistance.

If you do not have complete information on the other owner or driver <u>do not submit a</u> <u>report.</u>

The crash is not considered reportable unless sufficient information on the moving vehicle is provided.

If your insurance company requires a report, please provide a copy of this notice.
