HOW TO APPLY

- Complete and sign application; print clearly. Give the complete description of the Hobbyist vehicle in section **A**. Give the owner information in section **B**. Give the complete description of the vehicle currently registered in Wisconsin that you use for regular transportation in section **C**.
- If the vehicle is NOT titled in your name, send a completed title application (MV1 or MV11), appropriate fees and all application materials to the address below.

OR

If the vehicle is NOT currently registered, or is not designated as a Hobbyist vehicle type, you must send the original title (we are unable to accept a photocopy) and all application materials to:

- Using the fee schedule, determine Hobbyist registration fees. NO credit is given from current registration. If you are transferring a Hobbyist plate, you must pay the fee shown in the "Transfer" column. Make check or money order payable to: **Registration Fee Trust.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ♦ To qualify for Hobbyist plates you must first obtain a Wisconsin Certificate of Title issued in your name. You must also have at least one other motor vehicle used for regular transportation that is currently registered in Wisconsin in the same name(s) as the Hobbyist vehicle. This information must be completed in section C of the application.
- ♦ Operation of this vehicle is prohibited upon public roadways until the application is processed by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
- ♦ The Division of Motor Vehicles is unable to issue temporary plates for your vehicle during the processing time period.
- ♦ To legally operate autos or trucks registered at 8,000 pounds or less, you must wait for your title to be processed and the metal plates mailed to you.
- ♦ If your vehicle is not branded as "Street Modified" or "Replica," also complete the MV2855 for vehicle brand designation.
- ♦ Truck-type vehicles with Hobbyist plates cannot haul more than 500 pounds. To determine the approximate weight, use the weight of the vehicle with a full tank of gas and the equipment normally on the vehicle. Do not include the weight of a camper, lid or cap that is mounted on the truck or the weight of any persons or pets.
- ♦ By state law, Hobbyist plates CANNOT be personalized.
- ♦ Hobbyist plates are non-expiring for as long as you own the hobbyist vehicle. Vehicles with Hobbyist plates cannot be operated during the month of January unless a special temporary plate is purchased. These special temporary plates are available for \$5 for five consecutive days or \$30 for the month of January only; complete form MV2750.
- ♦ After you receive your Certificate of Registration, your first Hobbyist plates should arrive in 10 to 14 days. Allow 4 to 6 weeks for the manufacturing and mailing of subsequent Hobbyist plates.

WISCONSIN STATE PATROL INSPECTION LOCATIONS

All vehicles, including "Street Modified" and "Replicas" may be required to pass an inspection before title and registration can be processed. A passed inspection does not guarantee that a title or registration will be issued.

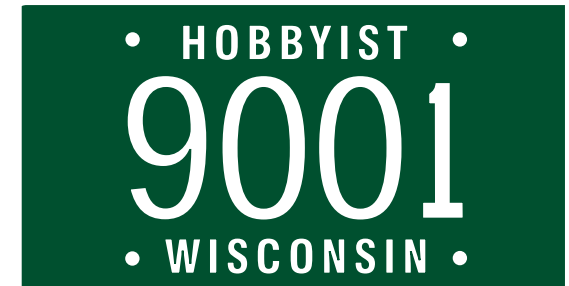
RELEASE OF NON EXEMPT INFORMATION
