## January 2022 HSIS Enhancements and Bug Fixes of Note

A new version of HSIS was released on 1/19/2022. The following is a list of some of the bugs fixed in this release. This release has no major enhancements.

Any screenshots or videos you can take are helpful.

## **Enhancements**

- 1) The routine inspection procedures are now visible for all inspection types. The routine inspection procedures can only be edited during a routine inspection.
- 2) Inspection procedures can be entered for all inspection types.
- 3) A note was added to General Inventory > File stating "additional files may be located at county/region offices." This does not mean there ARE additional files at these offices, but there might be.
- 4) Additional CAD file types can be uploaded with an inspection.

## **Bug Fixes**

The following bugs were fixed with this version. Additional bugs not listed below were also fixed.

- The bug causing a nullpointer to appear when clicking on certain entries under Inspection >
  History has been fixed.
- 2) A bug causing users to click "save" prior to navigating away from a structure that has an open inspection, even though the user didn't change anything, has been fixed.
- 3) The inventory tab for noise walls loads correctly.
- 4) When uploading a new cover photo, the image should refresh now.
