Subject: Statewide Crash Rates

The definition of a "reportable crash" changed starting January 1, 1996. For a Property Damage Only crash, the reporting threshold was raised from \$500 to \$1,000 to "any one person's property". Government-owned property changed to \$1,000 for government-owned vehicles, and remained at \$200 for all other government-owned property, such as traffic control devices.

The Table I lists the Wisconsin statewide crash rates for 2000-2004. These rates are expressed as crashes per 100 million vehicle-miles. The Division of Transportation Investment Management has provided the vehicle miles and the crashes are from the Accident File that is maintained by the Division of Motor Vehicles. The rates do not include non-reportable crashes (<\$1000).

Table II includes the 2000-2004 crash rates for the same highway classifications, as Table I, but is computed excluding hit deer crashes. Please note that this rate is just additional information and is being made available upon request. The official rates will be the ones shown in Table I, which include the deer hit crashes.

All the crashes that have happened on both urban STH and city streets have been combined into a single category called Urban Streets.
