Subject: November 2015 ISSUANCE

Listed below and placed in the BTO Manuals Library website are changes and additions to the Traffic Guidelines Manual. The following changes to the Traffic Guidelines Manual have been made:

- Replace Subject 1-5-5 Table of Contents
- Replace Subject 2-3-18 Merge Sign Locations – revised and refer to MUTCD
- Replace Subject 2-4-45.2 Emergency Medical Care Signing Policy – revised MUTCD references and added 2 facilities to listing
- Replace Subject 2-15-12 Wrong Way Prevention – updated policy to clarify median widths on divided highways when signing should be used.
- Add Subject 2-15-16 ATV Route Signing – new policy to assist staff when requests come in for ATV signing
- Replace Subject 2-15-30 Hydrant Signing – updated policy to clean up some language and sign codes.
- Add Subject 3-2-11 Raised Pavement Markers – new policy to address the temporary raised pavement markers (yellow tabs) on new pavement before permanent pavement marking can occur.
- Add Subject 3-15-15 Dynamic Envelope Markings – new policy addressing dynamic envelope pavement markings on State Highway System
- Add Subject 8-2-29 Dynamic Envelope Markings – new policy proposed for not allowing installation of dynamic envelope pavement markings on State Highway System near RR crossings.
- Add Subject 16-25-1 Traffic Model Peer Review Introduction – introduction to new guidance on conducting traffic model peer reviews
- Add Subject 16-25-2 Traffic Model Peer Review Process – new guidance on process for conducting traffic model peer reviews.
- Replace 17-1-1 DMS Policies & Procedures – updated policy (shown in yellow highlights) to address safety messaging and fire messaging as per DNR MOU.
