The following changes to the Traffic Guidelines Manual have been made:

- Replace subject 1-5-5 Table of Contents
- Replace subject 2-1-41 Jurisdictional Boundary Signs – updated to tie into the maintenance of signs policy (TGM 2-15-52)
- Replace subject 2-4-49 Street Name Signs – updated policy to address overhead street name sign lettering size
- Replace subject 2-15-6 Community Wayfinding Signs – updated policy with minor references to other TGM policies
- Replace subject 2-15-15 Recreational Trail Signing – updated policy to allow for National Trails signing in coordination with DNR.
- Replace subject 2-15-51 Routine Sign Replacement Criteria – minor updates to change improvement project reference to let project.
- Add subject 2-15-56 Signing for Diverging Diamond Interchanges – new policy to address signing of DDIs and provides sample sign layouts.
- Add subject 2-15-58 Specific Information Signs – new policy to provide statewide consistency and information on the vendor to contact
- Replace subject 17-1-1 Dynamic Message Signs – added language for safety messages and silver alerts.
