



SDD 15C7-c Pavement Marking Arrows





SDD 15C8 Pavement Marking, Mainline and Turn Lanes

Design Notes:

The bid item number used for words, symbols, and arrows depends upon the choice of material for the marking. See WisDOT Standard Specifications for Highway Structure Construction.

When bidding words, symbols, and arrows specify the kind of word, symbol, or arrow on the Miscellaneous Quantities list heading. There should be a list for every type of word, symbol, or arrow to be used.

The Pedestrian Word shall be used with the word "XING", place one set per lane.

Consult with the Regional Signing/Marking Engineer and Regional Bike and Ped Coordinator to determine the appropriate markings for bike accommodations.
