

<b>What is an involuntary transfer?</b>	An involuntary transfer of a motor vehicle is a transfer of ownership due to legal action or something other than a voluntary transfer.
<b>What is a repossession?</b>	Repossessions (MV2117 Repossession Application) are commonly processed at DMV Service Centers, as are MV2419 Abandoned/Unregistered Vehicle Transfer Certificate both of which are treated as involuntary transfers.
<b>Who would use this service?</b>	Anyone with an application that would fall under one of the categories described below needs to send the application to the Research and Information Unit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• no trace of ownership—an applicant seeking to title or register a vehicle without a certificate of title; the applicant must provide some proof of ownership of the vehicle</li><li>• <a href="http://wisconsin.gov/Pages/dmv/vehicles/title-plates/surety-bond.aspx">wisconsin.gov/Pages/dmv/vehicles/title-plates/surety-bond.aspx</a></li></ul>
