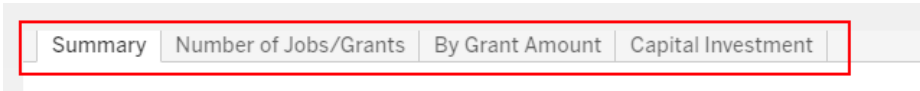


This user guide provides information on how to navigate and interact with the MAPSS Performance Improvement website dashboards and charts.

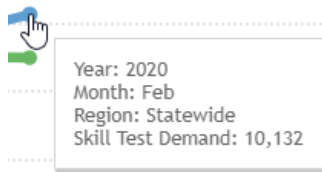
BASIC NAVIGATION

Some dashboards have tabs across the top of the screen, which correspond to different views. Select a tab to move to a different view.



UNDERSTANDING CHARTS AND DATA

Charts on the dashboard generally have an interactive 'Tooltip' that provides additional and specific data information.

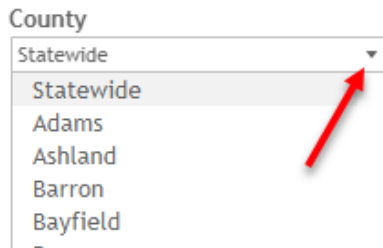


A tooltip for the chart can be activated by hovering the mouse cursor over the dot (computer) or selecting it with your finger (mobile device). The pop-up information box provides the specific month and count for this data point on the chart.

FILTERS

Dashboards often contain user-selectable filters, which allow a user to adjust the content and results to fit their specific needs. These filters allow a user to focus the visualization based on selected attributes, values or specific data.

DROPDOWN FILTERS



Click on the filter triangle to see available options.

CHART FILTERS

Charts on the dashboard are generally interactive (unless stated otherwise) and, when selected, they apply filtering to the other charts **on the same dashboard tab**.



A simple example is a performance measure map of the state. Clicking on a county within the map will filter other charts within the dashboard for that county's data.

The same is true for a bar, line or data chart. Clicking on a data point, chart value or date will filter the other charts of the dashboard.

Note: To multi-select values on any chart, hold CTRL button and left click. Or they can be selected using the mouse by "lassoing" the chart marks (this also works on maps). To do this on a cell phone the user should tap and hold on the map or chart to invoke the lasso.
