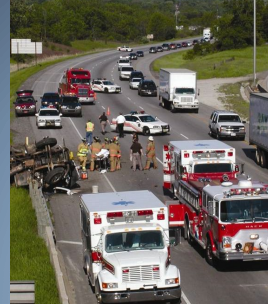


# Wisconsin Department of Transportation's Traffic Incident Management Enhancement (TIME) Program Training

WisDOT's Emergency Traffic Control and Scene Management Guidelines were established to provide incident responders within the state of Wisconsin a uniform approach to emergency traffic control and scene management. Having a uniform approach will help provide the safest possible work environment for all incident responders, minimize the risk for secondary crashes and aid in clearing an incident in a quick and effective manner. Class topics include:

- National Incident Management System (NIMS) and Incident Command System (ICS)
- Responder safety fundamentals
- Scene size-up and communications
- Traffic incident management area establishment
- Scene breakdown and demobilization
- Traveler information
- Hazardous materials response
- Helicopter emergency medical services landing zones
- Crash investigation/reconstruction
- Clearance/removal operations
- Emergency alternate routes
- Post incident debriefings

*This training is recommended for ALL incident responders, including law enforcement, fire, EMS, emergency dispatchers, highway department, department of public works, medical examiners / coroners and towing and recovery personnel. There is no cost for this training. Attendees will be provided with the Guidelines document, a field operations guide and other materials. Upon completion of the course, attendees will be provided with a certificate of completion.*
