Totally Opt Out of IOH Length and Weight Limits


Whereas, 2013 Wis. Act 377 under Sec. 348.27 (19) (b) 5.a. provides that a municipality or county may authorize implements of husbandry as defined in Sec. 340.01 (24) and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Sec. 340.01 (10) of Wis. Statutes to exceed any statutory length and weight limits imposed by the Chapter 348 of the Wis. Statutes.

Now, therefore, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Town Board of Germantown, of Juneau County, that pursuant to Sec. 348.27 (19)(b) 5.a. of Wis. Statutes, implements of husbandry and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined by Chapter 340 of Wis. Statutes may exceed any length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wis. Statutes.

Further, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that this resolution shall remain in effect until rescinded by further action of the board.

Further, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be provided to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to be posted on the state DOT website.
