

ENDING OF FROZEN ROAD DECLARATION

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) pursuant to Section 348.175, Wisconsin Statutes, ENDS the Frozen Road Declaration Statewide, as of March 16, 2019 at 12:01 AM.

Current road conditions and near normal temperatures mean that the subsurface below state highways will be thawing and heavier loads of specific commodities can no longer be allowed on these highways.

This declaration is for highways on the State Trunk Highway System ONLY. (This includes all State and US numbered highways statewide BUT not including any Interstate highways except that portion of IH 39 from the IH 90/94 interchange near Portage to the north and not including any state trunk highways where special weight restrictions have been imposed)
