Housekeeping	Work or Homemaker
Landlord	Work, Self-employed or list employer
Looking for work	Homemaker
Medical appointment	Homemaker
Nanny	Work - List employer
National Guard	Work, give title and employer (US Army, etc)
Probation/Parole Visit/officer	Homemaker
Recreation activities	Not allowed
Reservist	Work, give title and employer (US Army, etc)
Riding lessons	Not allowed
Self-employed	Work – Self employed
Skating lessons	Not allowed
Student	To and from school and curricular activities allowed. Not allowed for extra-curricular activities (no credit toward graduation; i.e., sports, dances, etc.)
Traffic Safety School	Student – List school
Vacation	Not allowed

Veterinarian appointment	Homemaker
