Executive Order 110 Emergency Oversize-Overweight Permit 06/15/2021

This permit is to be issued exclusively for efforts associated with Executive order #110 issued on April 5th, 2021, Relating to Declaring a State of Emergency in Response to Elevated Wildfire Conditions. This permit is authorized under Wis. Stats. s. 348.27(3). and the emergency authority under Wis. Admin. Code s. Trans 230.01(3)(c)4., pursuant to EmR2115.

Permit is valid only for the transportation of raw forest products, lumber, or forestry biomass on routes specified below.

- State HWY 64 between Antigo WI and Marinette WI.
- State HWY 32 between Mountain WI. and Laona WI.
- US HWY 141 from the junction of 141 and 64 in Pound North to Pembine.
- State HWY 55 from the junction of 55 and 64 near Langlade, north to the junction of 55 and 8 in Crandon.
- State HWY 52 from 10 miles east to 10 miles west of the junction of 55 and 52.
- US HWY 41 from Abrams to Marinette.

This permit does not authorize operation on municipal, town or county roads unless the city, village, town or county official with legal control of the road gives written approval for use of the road. Written approval must be carried with the permit and carried in the truck.

Vehicle configuration and length must comply with Michigan vehicle size law and may exceed 75 feet for Michigan configured B trains. **Standard Overweight fees will apply for this permit.**

In addition, a permit issued under this subsection does not authorize the operation of any vehicle or vehicle combination at a maximum gross weight in excess of 164,000 pounds. A 164,000-pound vehicle combination must have 11 or more axles.

This Executive Order #110 Emergency Oversize-Overweight Permit is valid through October 5th, 2021.
