## **Executive Order #35 emergency oversize-overweight permit**

### **Updated 03/31/2020 to allow travel on specific routes during spring thaw.**

During spring thaw declaration period 2020, this permit is valid only for the transportation of raw forest products or forestry biomass on two routes specified here:

- US HWY 141 from the junction of CTH Z in Beecher north to US HWY 8
- US HWY 8 from the junction of US HWY 141 east to the Michigan county line.

Once spring thaw restrictions are lifted this permit will be valid only for the transportation of raw forest products, lumber or forestry biomass on these five routes only and will expire when 2021 spring thaw restrictions go into effect.

- State HWY 64 between Antigo WI and Marinette WI.
- State HWY 32 between Mountain WI. and Laona WI.
- US HWY 141 from the junction of 141 and 64 in Pound North to Pembine.
- State HWY 55 from the junction of 55 and 64 near Langlade, north to the junction of 55 and 8 in Crandon.
- State HWY 52 from 10 miles east to 10 miles west of the junction of 55 and 52.

This permit does not authorize operation on municipal, town or county roads unless the city, village, town or county official with legal control of the road gives written approval for use of the road. Written approval must be carried with the permit and carried in the truck.

Vehicle configuration and length must comply with Michigan vehicle size law and may exceed 75 feet for Michigan configured B trains.

In addition, a permit issued under this subsection does not authorize the operation of any vehicle or vehicle combination at a maximum gross weight in excess of 164,000 pounds. A 164,000-pound vehicle combination must have 11 or more axles.

This Executive Order #35 emergency oversize-overweight permit is valid until spring thaw (2021 Class II) declarations are issued impacting the designated routes or unless the department deems necessary.
