

UPDATE: Notification of OSOW permit suspensions due to emergency flooding

Update: 9/13/2018

Effective 12:01 a.m. Monday, September 17,
the OSOW permit suspension in the flood impacted zone
is revised as follows:

- **Multiple trip permit holders** traveling in the impacted flood zone (below) that was established in the initial suspension dated 8/28/18 may return to normal permit conditions within that zone **with these exceptions:**
 - **Must get approvals from Townships and Municipalities** for travel on local roads.
 - **Must check 511wi.gov** prior to travel for **list of currently closed State roadway segments.**
 - Approval from **County** authorities is not required unless your multiple trip permit specifically requires it.
- **Single trip permit holders** traveling in the impacted zone may return to normal permit operation.
 - As always, single trip holders are required to contact local authorities for permission to travel on local roads.

Additional information:

- Authority to impose additional permit restrictions authorized under Chapter Trans 255.12 (7)., Chapter Trans 260.11, Chapter Trans 269.10 (3) and Trans Rule 348.27, sub 15 (d).
- The Department may amend or suspend permits at any time should weather and/or system conditions warrant.
- These restrictions will be in place until local systems are fully evaluated and conditions warrant adjustments.
- Carriers are required to always adhere to local posted road and structure restrictions.
- Carriers should **always** check [the state 511 system \(511wi.gov\)](http://the.state.511.system(511wi.gov)) or [@511WI](https://twitter.com/511WI) on Twitter for the most current closures and restrictions. **However**, 511WI does not include local system restrictions and/or closures.

WI-21 east to

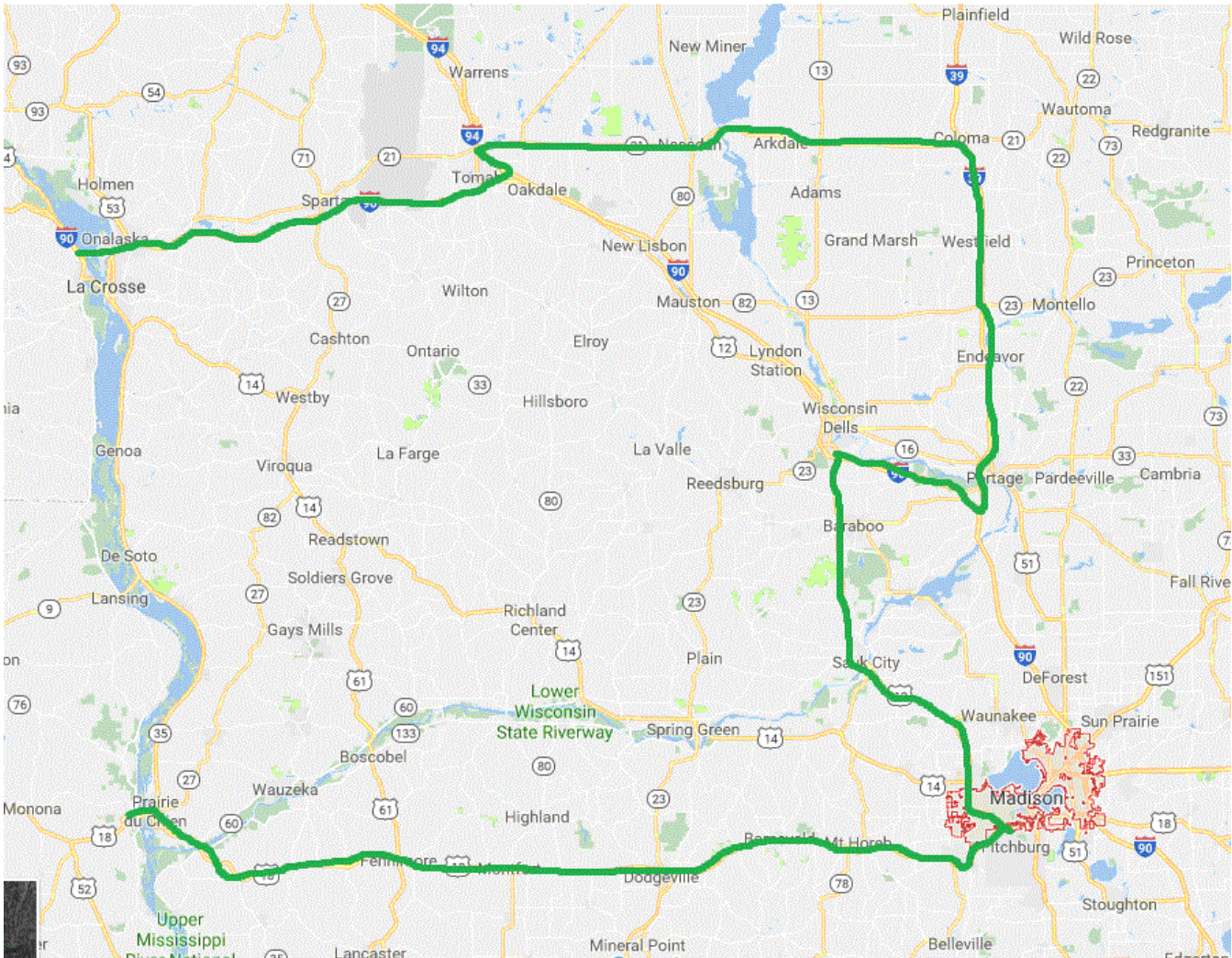
I-39 south at Coloma to
