  - **Mini-Bus Program - 608-637-5201 or 888-637-1323:** The Vernon County Mini-Bus is available to those in need of transportation for any reason including appointments, shopping and social opportunities for a small fare. Each weekday it is scheduled to take passengers to specific destinations including La Crosse, Richland Center, Viroqua and Madison. The mini-bus is handicapped accessible. **Rides must be reserved by calling the Unit on Aging at 608 637-5201 before 3:00 pm the weekday before the ride is required.** You are encouraged to call to make your travel arrangements at the same time as you schedule an appointment. <https://www.vernoncounty.org/ADRC/Transportation.htm>
  - **Vernon County Volunteer Driver Escort Service Program: Volunteer Driver Program -** Vernon County residents of all ages can request rides to and from destinations within a 100-mile radius of Viroqua. This is a door-through-door service. Riders are picked up from a starting location and are taken to their requested destination. Co-payments are based on mileage.
