Who should participate?

This training will offer contractors who work on Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) construction projects with information and resources on how to meet prevailing wage and certified payroll reporting requirements.

What topics will be covered?

The **Contractor Training** will cover contract requirements for WisDOT projects including identifying Federally funded projects, Davis-Bacon Federal Wage Determinations, Additional Special Provisions (ASPs), Federal law overtime, fringe benefits, deductions, paying correctly, apprentices, job site posting board, trucking, roles and responsibilities, and contract compliance investigations.

The **Civil Rights Compliance System (CRCS) Training** is geared towards all user levels and will walk through user functions such as modifying company and employee information, finding project details and wages, submitting payrolls, running reports, and assigning subcontractors.
