DBE Support Services provides training, assistance and professional services to minority, disadvantaged, and women-owned business enterprises to increase their activity on WisDOT contract opportunities and to facilitate firms' development into more viable, self-sufficient enterprises prepared to compete, perform and profit on federally-funded contracts.

DBE BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

WisDOT's Business Development Program exists to improve the quality and scope of contracting relationships for DBE certified firms starting with a comprehensive assessment that generates training tailored to increase annual contract volume and/or amounts to participating DBE firms. Our goal is to develop DBE firms that can compete successfully in the marketplace outside of the DBE Program.

TRANS ON-THE-JOB TRAINING

Transportation Alliance for New Solutions (TrANS) is WisDOT's construction preparation program designed to supply WisDOT contractors with a pool of "pre-qualified", career-ready workers that represent the communities impacted by federal transportation contracts. TrANS strives to promote skilled trades careers to women and minorities by providing direct access to contractors and paths to apprenticeship in highway

EEO CONTRACTOR COMPLIANCE

Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Contractor Compliance ensures that construction contractors and subcontractors who work on federally-funded highway contracts comply with nondiscrimination and affirmative action requirements. Staff conduct desk audits and site interviews of employment practices.
