NEW WisDOT Certified Payroll Report Process for 2025

WisDOT is preparing to phase out CRCS and transition to AASHTOWare Project (AWP), Civil Rights and Labor (CRL) payroll module. [AWP Knowledge Base Payrolls click here](#).

- Certified Payroll Reports (CPRs) for projects let on or after January of 2025 will need to be entered in AWP CRL.
- Projects already in CRCS will **NOT** be moved to CRL.
- Vendors may need to enter payrolls into CRCS **and** CRL until projects in CRCS are completed.
- Access to the AWP CRL payroll program and more information will be available early next year.



WisDOT Vendor Registration System (VRS)

New vendors will need to register in Vendor Registration System (VRS).

- Each vendor will have a main user referred to as the **Vendor Admin User**. To log in to the Vendor Registration System you will need to have a WAMS ID. [Create a WAMS ID link](#).
- The **Vendor Admin User** will login to VRS using WAMS and Password. [VRS site link](#).
- The **Vendor Admin User** will review and update all company information in VRS.

Add Emergency Contact Info to DMV Record

WisDOT DMV now offers an option for individuals to add emergency contact information to their driver license or ID record.



- Adding the information is voluntary.
- Will not appear on the card.
- Provides law enforcement ability to contact family member or loved one more quickly in the event of an emergency.
- Only law enforcement, including in other states, are able access the information.
