## 2018 Labor Compliance Training & Civil Rights Compliance System (CRCS) Training

Sessions are offered at multiple locations statewide



### *Who should attend?*

Training will offer contractors who perform highway construction projects with information and resources pursuant to meeting prevailing wage requirements and certified payroll reporting requirements.

### *What topics will be covered?*

The **Labor Compliance Training** will cover how the repeal of Wisconsin's Prevailing Wage Law under Act 59 will affect state-funded only projects, (including Additional Special Provision 9-S) and all applicable contract requirements for projects with federal funds (including FHWA-1273), the revised Supplemental Required Contract Provisions, new trucking guidelines, job site postings, etc.

The **Payroll Reporting/CRCS Training** portion will be led by Paul Ndon and is geared towards all user levels and will walk through user functions such as modifying company and employee information, finding project details and wages, submitting payrolls, running reports, and assigning subcontractors.
