Who should attend?

Training will offer contractors who perform highway construction projects with information and resources regarding contract compliance, prevailing wage, and certified payroll reporting requirements.

What topics will be covered?

The **Labor Compliance Training** will cover applicable contract requirements for Wisconsin DOT projects including FHWA-1273, Supplemental Required Contract Provisions, prevailing wage, trucking guidelines, job site postings, prompt payment, etc.

The **Payroll Reporting/CRCS Training** portion will be led by Paul Ndon. This training is geared towards all user levels and will walk through user functions such as modifying company and employee information, finding project details and wages, submitting payrolls, running reports, and assigning subcontractors.
