Who should participate?

This training is geared toward new contractors, employees, and anyone who missed the March-April 2022 training. It is for anyone who works on Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) highway construction projects. The sessions will provide information and resources on how to meet prevailing wage and certified payroll reporting requirements using March-April 2022 materials.

What topics will be covered?

The **Contractor Training** will cover contract requirements for WisDOT projects including identifying Federally funded projects, Davis-Bacon Federal Wage Determinations, Additional Special Provisions (ASP's), Federal law overtime, fringe benefits, deductions, paying correctly, apprentices, job site posting board, trucking, roles and responsibilities, and contract compliance investigations.

The **Civil Rights Compliance System (CRCS) Training** is an opportunity for all user levels and will walk through user functions such as modifying company and employee information, finding project details and wages, submitting payrolls, running reports, and assigning subcontractors.

No registration required.

WisDOT will be logged on 10 minutes prior to the training if you would like to check for any technical difficulties.
