

ADA TRANSITION PLAN 2021 UPDATE

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I. INTRODUCTION

It is the policy of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) to ensure that its programs, services, activities, and facilities are accessible to and usable by individuals with disabilities in accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504) and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA). The ADA Transition Plan provides information about WisDOT's efforts to ensure accessibility on the "*Path to Zero*" barriers in its public right-of-way. WisDOT's ADA Transition Plan was accepted as substantially meeting the regulatory minimum requirements of the ADA by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) on February 25, 2020.

WisDOT's ADA Transition Plan is a "living document" and is updated annually.¹ The WisDOT Secretary, Craig Thompson, is the official responsible for the implementation of the ADA Transition Plan. WisDOT's ADA Program is administered by the Office of Business Opportunity and Equity Compliance (OBOEC) in the Division of Transportation System Development. OBOEC coordinates a multi-disciplinary approach to implement and manage WisDOT's compliance efforts. These efforts include complaint investigation, processing reasonable accommodation requests, staffing the ADA Managing Committee, and monitoring the overall progress of the implementation of the ADA Transition Plan. The ADA Program Coordinator acts as the primary contact for all public outreach pertaining to discrimination against people with disabilities. II. PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FACILITIES

A. Accessible Pedestrian Signals

WisDOT owns and operates 15 accessible pedestrian signals. Six signals were installed in 2013, three in 2018, and six in 2020. WisDOT coordinates with local public agencies for maintenance of its signals on connecting highways (connecting highways are local streets and roads that carry state highway travel through cities and villages).

B. Curb Ramps

1. Inventory

A desktop inventory was conducted in 2014-15 to identify existing curb ramps and sidewalks along state highways including connecting highways or within the state highway right-of-way. The inventory was based on visual inspection using WisDOT Photolog, Google Street View, and satellite imagery. The inventory information was captured as Geographic Information System (GIS) data. This inventory is annually updated with post construction data on curb ramps and field survey data replaces the desktop inventory data. The data acquired through the inventory includes an estimated 49,000 curb ramp locations. See *Appendix E* for link to data.

The data regarding sidewalks and shared-use paths along state highways including connecting highways or within state highway right-of-way is a total of 1,483 linear miles, with 1,323 linear miles as sidewalk.

2. Six-Year Highway Improvement Program

WisDOT began tracking curb ramps installed/updated in 2019. In the 2020 construction season, it was estimated that approximately 1,000 curb ramp locations would be addressed each year as part of the Six-year Program. In the 2020 construction season, WisDOT completed 49 improvement projects which installed/updated approximately 1,400 curb ramps on the state trunk network. See *Appendix F – Six-year Program projects completed in 2020* and *Appendix G – Six-year Program projects scheduled for completion in 2021*.

It is estimated that 1,000 to 1,500/year curb ramp locations will be addressed in the next program cycle. These estimates are based on the number of projects in the 2022-2027 Six-year Program that meet the definition of an ADA alteration. See *Appendix H – Six-year Program projects scheduled for 2022-2027*.

3. Standalone Curb Ramp Improvement Program

WisDOT has developed a standalone curb ramp improvement program that will address curb ramp locations that are not within a roadway improvement project in the Six-year Program. This is an annual program solely focused on installing and updating curb ramps. The base LET goal for this program without delivery is \$5 million in annual state fiscal year funding. Yearly allocations to the program will be made through the State Highway Rehabilitation (SHR) subprogram. The schedule for the Standalone Curb Ramp Improvement Program is to prioritize and address all non-programmed curb ramp locations within 3 six-year program cycles (18 years). This is separate from the Six-year Program described in #2 above. It is estimated that approximately 1,000 curb ramp locations will be addressed each year over a six-year period. In 2020, project areas for the Standalone Curb Ramp Improvement Program were identified and programmed with projects scheduled for construction starting in 2026. See *Appendix I – Standalone Curb Ramp Improvement Program projects*.

A pilot project for the Standalone Curb Ramp Improvement Program began in 2019. The pilot project is separated into two phases to adjust for real estate acquisition. The first phase of the pilot project constructed curb ramps in 2020 that did not need real estate. The second phase is finalizing design, acquiring real estate, and scheduled for construction in 2024. The pilot project experience has been informative in the overall development of the statewide program.

III. OTHER FACILITIES

A. Buildings

WisDOT owns and operates 41 facilities that include regional offices, training centers, storage buildings, materials labs, and warehouses. WisDOT leases its main headquarters building from the Wisconsin Department of Administration.

B. DMV Customer Service Centers

WisDOT owns, leases, and shares office space for 91 Division of Motor Vehicle (DMV) customer service centers. An ADA Assessment was conducted in 2010. Accessibility barriers identified at DMV customer service centers are removed through the Capital Improvement Budget process.

C. Rest Areas

WisDOT owns and operates 28 rest areas. A comprehensive inventory and study of assets was conducted in 2016. The Roadside Facilities Unit contracted with Mead & Hunt, Inc. for an ADA Assessment of 3 rest areas in 2021. Those rest areas are in or near Beloit, Janesville, and Kenosha on the interstate highway system.

D. Safety and Weight Enforcement Facilities

WisDOT owns and operates 13 safety and weight enforcement facilities (inspection facilities and truck scales). A comprehensive inventory and study of assets was conducted in 2016. The Roadside Facilities Unit contracted with Mead & Hunt, Inc. for an ADA Assessment of 2 safety and weight enforcement facilities in 2021. Those facilities are Hudson and Wrightstown.

IV. TRAINING

A. 2021 Transportation Improvement Conference: ADA Curb Ramps

This training session is designed to provide participants with a detailed understanding of the design of accessible sidewalks, curb ramps, signals, etc. and the relationship to project scope. Using an example-based approach, participants were guided through several pilot efforts to demonstrate the role of effective scoping, context-based design approaches, technical infeasibility challenges and best practices. This course provides the context for the role of compliance in the broader goal of accessibility.



J. Public Comments received in 2020**COMMENTS**

WisDOT received two comments during the public comment period and continues to invite input through its website. WisDOT coordinates internally with appropriate program areas to address each comment. Below are the comments and responses.

Comment

I applaud the plans to increase accessibility to persons of all abilities. However, I keep finding a limited viewpoint when it comes to determining appropriateness of access. Most focus on persons in wheelchairs or motorized scooters. But for someone like myself, who still walks with assistance but tends to have limited endurance, our needs are overlooked. Many times the route that is accessible is made longer, either to take into account changes in grade or terrain. But that usually provides a barrier for myself - I just cannot tolerate the additional distance. This problem can be mitigated by providing resting spots (chairs, benches) and trying to keep the distances short. At most rest stops I find even from a handicap accessible parking space the distance to the restroom is too distant for me to walk. As a result, I do not even consider using rest areas as a stopping point. I ask that in your plan you consider addressing this issue.

Responsible Area: Bureau of Highway Maintenance and Bureau of Planning and Economic Development

Thank you for your comment. WisDOT follows the Americans with Disabilities Act Design Guidelines (ADAAG) and Public Rights-of-Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG) to ensure reasonable and consistent processes are used in the design, construction or alteration of pedestrian facilities that are part of state highway network. As part of these planning and design processes the department evaluates options to meet the design standards and improve accessibility on a project by project basis as well as considering the overall site conditions. As the department reviews and updates program policies and procedures to ensure ADA compliance, public comments received are also considered and incorporated accordingly. Again, thank you for your comments.

Comment

I am employed with North Country Independent Living. As an Independent Living Specialist I enrolled persons with disabilities in our Transportation Voucher Program. Our funding was cut 40%. With the overall population now experiencing isolation getting a taste of what persons with disabilities experience always. In Sawyer Co. subsidized housing is in Winter and Radisson. From Winter to shopping opportunities, the distance is 30 miles one way. Prior to the 40% cut, we were able to give 250 miles in vouchers per month which would allow for travel 4 trips per month. After the cut 150 miles allowing for only 2 trips per month. Medical transport does not allow for shopping needs even when the consumers are driven right past the grocery store. We also provide rides for cancer treatments, dialysis as well as other health conditions. Please restore our funding!

Responsible Area: Bureau of Transit, Local Roads, Railroads, and Harbors

The Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program utilizes federal and state funds for projects that improve the mobility of seniors and individuals with disabilities. The

Section 5310 program is an annual competitive grant program. Eligible projects are evaluated based on criteria listed in the application guidelines. Applicants that score well are more likely to receive funding.

Grant applications for calendar year 2022 Section 5310 funding are due to WisDOT by August 27, 2021.

State and Federal grant funds vary from year to year. Section 5310 funding demand often outstrips supply. The WisDOT 5310 Program website outlines the previous year's applicants and awards -

WisDOT strives to ensure all worthy, eligible projects are funded as much as possible. In most years, the department must make difficult funding decisions and issues partial awards to successful applicants. In early 2021, WisDOT received two federal 5310 funding supplements in response to the COVID-19 pandemic – one through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and the other through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). And, the recently passed Wisconsin State Budget includes a 2.5% increase to the 85.22 program, which supplements the federal Section 5310 program funds, for the next two years. This additional funding helps meet the near record demands for grant funding.

WisDOT recognizes that the limited funding directly impacts mobility services for seniors and individuals with disabilities, and it will continue to pursue increased program funding opportunities at the state and federal levels.
