2) Environmental Justice/Title VI-What are your team's EJ and Title VI engagement qualifications from the past 5 years? How do you propose WisDOT utilize innovative techniques to expand reach, receive meaningful feedback, and maximize benefit of all engagement efforts?
3) Stakeholder and Public Engagement-What are your team's stakeholder and public engagement qualifications from the past 5 years? How do you propose WisDOT utilize innovative techniques to expand reach, receive meaningful feedback, and maximize benefit of all engagement efforts?
4) Web-based planning portal development- What are your team's qualifications to build a web-based planning portal that will be a one-stop shop for planning efforts, including the Plan, technical reports, and modal plans?
5) Data collection and visualization development-What are your team's qualifications to build a data collection and visualization app to increase the ease collecting public engagement data, increase data quality, and use data visualization techniques to show the data in easily understandable ways?
