- 2) Public Involvement and Effective Community Engagement (approach; local issues; how partner w/community orgs) - What are your team's qualifications, capacity to deliver, and strategies for success on this project?
- 3) Integrating Land Use Planning (understanding/vision of current use; potential uses/development; reconnecting communities) - What are your team's qualifications, capacity to deliver, and strategies for success on this project?



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- 4) Integrating Alternative Modes of Transportation (Bike; Ped; Transit; Green Infrastructure; etc.) What are your team's qualifications, capacity to deliver, and strategies for success on this project?
- 5) Traffic Operations and Safety Analysis and Modeling What are your team's qualifications, capacity to deliver, and strategies for success on this project?
