COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This 80-hour course taught by State Patrol Motorcycle Operator Instructors will:

Orient class to the terminology, driving skills, and liability issues that relate to the operation of a police motorcycle.

This training enhances an officer's ability to operate a police motorcycle in a variety of situations by teaching personal and vehicle control limitations.

ITEMS TO BRING:

- Helmet: United States Department of Transportation (DOT) approved motorcycle helmet in good condition and free of defects
- Eye Protection- Shatter resistant eyeglasses, sunglasses, safety glasses (for day use). Clear eyeglasses, clear safety glasses (nighttime or low light use)
- Gloves: Full finger
- Long Pants: Blue Jeans or BDU type pants, loose fitting while in the seated position
- Lace up boots: Cover above the ankle with good grip soles. No leather soles!
- Long Sleeves (shirt or jacket) for higher speed exercises (optional)
- Rain Gear for inclement weather
- Optional Personal items: sunscreen, bug spray, refillable water bottle

PREREQUISITES:

- Certified LESB Law Enforcement Officer.
- VALID CLASS M Driver's License.
