COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Scenario Instructor Course is designed to provide instructors working with preparatory training academies; the knowledge, tools and understanding of the safety and administrative needs associated with scenario training and testing activities. The course goal is to prepare instructor personnel to provide realistic, safe and effective preparatory level training and assessments, as well as to serve as a safety protocol aid (although not mandatory) for active law enforcement/jail, in-service and law enforcement/jail community training programs. The course objectives are established through the roles and functions of the Safety Coordinator (SO) and the Exercise Control Officer (ECO) and common safety practices, as outlined in the scenario instructor training manual. Objectives included in the manual consist of; coaching techniques, debriefing techniques, evaluation, directing of role players and ensuring compliance with established safety protocols to list a few. This course emphasizes teaching and learning techniques that promote active learning, support learners with a variety of learning preferences and needs and generates continuous improvements in teaching and learning activities.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Identify the expectations of the Scenario instructor training program
- Examine the consequences of inadequate safety monitoring/practices
- Identify the significant differences between recruit training scenarios and testing scenarios and other forms of training in the preparatory academies
- Identify the safety requirements needed prior to, during and after a scenario event
- Utilize safety protocols and equipment
- Identify non-safety procedures and policies for scenario training and testing
- Critique the scenario instructor course

PREREQUISITES:

- Completed Criminal Justice Instructor Development Course (CJ-IDC)
- Complete Instructor Training Course Application DJ-LE-336
 - State Patrol employees should bring the form completed and it will be signed at the Academy.
 - Personnel from outside of the DSP need to have the form signed by an administrator from their agency and submit a copy to the Academy in advance of admission to the course.
- Complete the Student Release of Information DJ-LE-310

- This is an instructor course. Anyone attending the instructor course is expected to know the below skills prior to attending the course.
 - You must complete all mandatory Performance Assessment Tasks.
 - You must pass the final written test with a score of 80% or higher.
