COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This class will prepare instructor candidates for certification as a Tactical Response instructor. Graduates of this class will be able to instruct officers in building and room-clearing, response to violent incidents including active shooter incidents.

Identify instructor responsibilities.

Describe the components of the Tactical Response curriculum.

Review decision-making and legal issues surrounding use of force decisions.

Review tactics for everyday patrol including foot pursuits, small unit tactics, and perimeters; teaching and correcting student errors.

Review active shooter response concepts and principles, teaching and correcting student errors.

Present teaching assignments.

Complete the Tactical Response Instructor course (exam, evaluation, review application process)

PREREQUISITES:
