



Amateur Radio License Plate Information and Application

Who is eligible?

- ▶ Any Wisconsin resident.

Vehicles that qualify

- ▶ An automobile.
- ▶ A motor home (annual registration only).
- ▶ A private truck, dual-purpose motor home or dual-purpose farm truck that has a gross weight of 8,000 pounds or less.
- ▶ A farm truck that has a gross weight.

Things you should know

- ▶ Amateur Radio plates (AMA) are issued to a customer who holds a current Federal Communications Commission (FCC) amateur radio license.
- ▶ The same plate number can be registered to more than one vehicle.
- ▶ There is only one AMA plate for auto, trucks, farm, etc. The plate is processed with a plate type of AMA and a REG TYPE, which indicates the type of vehicle to which the plate is registered.

Fees needed

- ▶ A \$15 one time issuance fee
- ▶ The annual registration fee, if your current plates expire within 3 months

Plates required in 2 days

To legally operate your vehicle, you must display license plates within two business days of purchase.

If you do not have current plates, you may apply with a 3rd party agent to obtain a temporary plate while your amateur radio plate order is processed. An agent may charge a plate fee and/or service fee.

How to apply

1. Complete and sign application.
 - » Select appropriate option.
 - » Give complete description of the vehicle in section **A**.
 - » Give owner information in section **B**.
 - » Incomplete applications will be returned.
2. If the vehicle you wish to register with Amateur Radio plates is already titled in your name and is currently registered, send a copy of your Certificate of Registration.
3. If the vehicle is **not** titled in your name, send a completed title application ([MV1](#) or MV11), assigned title and fees, including Amateur Radio registration fees.
4. Send this application with A copy of your valid FCC license (we will not accept this if it is expired). Make check or money order payable to: **Registration Fee Trust**.

Amateur Radio plates are not available or processed at DMV Customer Service Centers. Operation of this vehicle is prohibited upon public highways without proper registration displayed.
