Maximum size and weight for which a single trip permit may be granted:

Length - Single vehicle 50 ft. Mobile crane 60 ft.

Weight Limitation

Gross Weight In Pounds

Steering Axle	20,000
Any Other Axle	35,000

Additional weight limitations
may be imposed by route.

The overall length, width and height of other loads depends on type of load.

If the spacing between adjacent axles is less than 42 inches, the axle can carry no more than a single axle.

Maximum size for which a single trip permit may be granted:

Overall Length	110 feet
Mobile Home or Modular Only	80 feet
Overall Width limitations will be determined by route.

The permittee shall have at least the following insurance coverage in full force and effect on the vehicle and load designated in the permit while operating on the public highway.

Property Damage Liability - each accident	300,000		Single Limit	400,000

Group A Applies when a permitted vehicle and load do not exceed 12 feet in width, 13 1/2 feet in height,
or 100 feet in length, and do not exceed statutory gross weight limits by more than 25%.

Group B Applies when permit is issued for any dimension in excess of those for Group A.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Online applications accept eCheck/ACH and credit card. Apply at <https://wi.gotpermits.com/wiconnect>
2. If application is mailed in, make checks payable to: **Registration Fee Trust**. The fee must accompany the application and will be retained by the Department only if a permit is issued.

PROCEDURE TO CALCULATE FEES

1. No charge shall be made for a change when an error was made by the issuing authority.
2. All charges for the transmission of an application or a permit, other than by U.S. Mail, are in addition to the permit fee and are the responsibility of the applicant.
3. No charge shall be made to any state department, county, town, municipality, or any branch of the United States Government or the Armed Services for any type of oversize/overweight permit.
4. A charge of \$10.00 per district will be made when, by reason of the size or weight of the vehicle or load, the route must be reviewed by a regional highway office.
5. A charge of \$10.00 per review will be made when, by reason of the gross weight of the vehicle and load, a review is necessary of specific highway structures.
6. Permit fees are established by s.348.25 Wisconsin Statutes and Wisconsin Administrative Code Trans. 250.
