Project Needs

- The following project needs have been identified:
 - The asphalt pavement is deteriorating.
 - The County L and County A intersections will be evaluated to address crashes.
 - Improve the overall safety of the corridor.





- We are proposing to improve 2.5 miles of US 8 as follows:
 - Milling the surface layer of existing asphalt and overlaying it with new asphalt.
 - Installing new permanent signing.
 - Installing new pavement markings.
 - Re-align the Hiawatha Trail crossing.





- Proposed intersection improvement alternatives for County L and County A include:
 - Two-Way Stop Controlled Intersections
 - Roundabout Intersections



Proposed Traffic Impacts

- Proposed traffic impacts:
 - Staged single lane closures.
 - Temporary driveway closures will be necessary.
 - Local, business, and emergency access will be maintained.
 - Construction currently scheduled to begin as early as the spring/summer of 2026 and estimated to take five months to complete.
- Work will be staged to help minimize traffic impacts during local events.





Real Estate

 Additional right of way may be required for this project. Direct mailings and coordination will occur with affected property owners.
