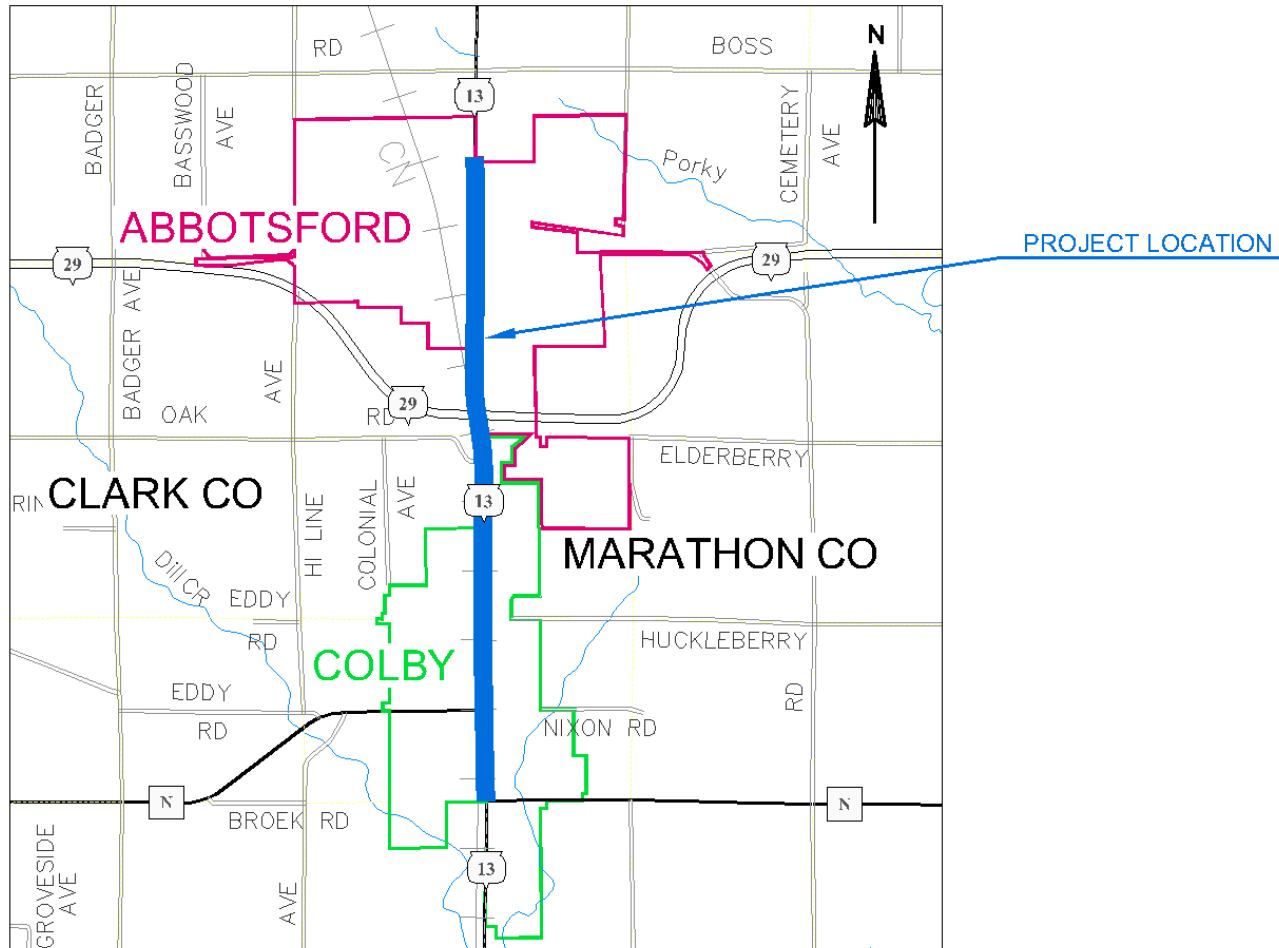

Project location



Purpose and need

- Deteriorating pavement
- Existing curb ramps do not meet current ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) standards

Proposed improvements

- Mill and overlay of the asphaltic pavement
- Upgrade all curb ramps to meet ADA standards
- Reshaping and restoring the existing gravel shoulders
- New pavement marking

Real estate needs

- Minor permanent fee and temporary limited easement is needed
 - Curb ramp improvements
- Acquisition process
 - WisDOT will acquire real estate
 - Real estate staff will coordinate with property owners
 - Real estate acquisitions will begin in winter 2021
- Landowner rights information available on the project website

Proposed construction staging

- Maintaining safety and mobility are important during construction
 - Northbound and southbound through traffic will be maintained on WIS 13
- Proposed traffic impacts
 - Lane closures
 - Flaggers at major intersections
 - Temporary closures of minor side streets
 - Short-term overnight ramp closures at WIS 29
 - Local and emergency access will be maintained
 - Temporary pedestrian access will be provided

Current project schedule

- Project notification letters – October/November 2019
- Preliminary design and plans – April 2020
- Final environmental document – September 2020
- Virtual local officials meeting – October 2020
- Public involvement– November/December 2020
- Final right of way plat – December 2020
- Real estate negotiations – Winter 2021 to spring 2022
- Final plans – August 2022
- Construction – 2023
