## Welcome

Welcome to the public involvement meeting to discuss WIS 153 between Rangeline Road and Water Street, in Mosinee.

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to:

- Present information regarding the current condition of the roadway
- Provide information about the proposed improvements
- Answer your questions
- Obtain your input

A presentation is scheduled to begin at 5 p.m. After the presentation, the meeting will follow an open house format.


WisDOT representatives will be available to answer questions throughout the meeting.

## Project information

We've identified the following needs:

- The pavement on WIS 153 (Western Avenue, 4<sup>th</sup> Street, and Main Street) pavement is deteriorating and nearing the end of its useful life.
- Sections of the curb and gutter, and multiple storm sewer structures, are deteriorated and require replacement or repair.
- A majority of the pedestrian curb ramps do not meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
- The traffic signal equipment at the intersection of Main Street and 4<sup>th</sup> Street needs improvement.

### Project location map



Proposed improvements include:

- Replacing the pavement and curb and gutter between Rangeline Road and Novak Street.
- Milling the pavement between Novak Street and Water Street and overlaying the surface with new asphalt.
- Replacing deteriorated curb and gutter sections between Novak Street and Water Street.
- Repairing all deteriorated storm sewer structures.
- Replacing all non-ADA pedestrian curb ramps with curb ramps that meet current ADA standards.
- Replacing the traffic signal equipment at Main Street and 4th Street.
- Constructing new 5-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of WIS 153 between Rangeline Road and Novak Street. The new sidewalk will be located approximately 4 to 5 feet behind the curb.
- The city plans to replace the city water services between Rangeline Road and Novak Street.

## **Traffic impacts during construction**

Construction is currently scheduled to begin in early summer 2020.

WIS 153 will remain open to one lane in each direction. Motorists can expect to encounter traffic shifts, flagging operations, on-street parking restrictions, temporary traffic signals, and temporary side road closures.

There will be brief periods of time when construction operations are occurring directly in front of the driveways to construct new concrete aprons between Rangeline Road and Novak Street. The property owner will need to park on a side street or use a secondary driveway if one is available. The contractor will be required to contact homeowners and businesses approximately 48 hours prior to closing a driveway.

Construction is currently scheduled for completion in fall 2020.

## **Real estate**

Temporary easements are needed to blend the improvements into the areas behind the sidewalks at the following locations:

- For construction of the new sidewalk along the north side of WIS 153 between Rangeline Road and Novak Street
- Where pedestrian curb ramps are being replaced

Right of way acquisitions will be required to allow pedestrian curb ramps improvements.

## Project update/next steps

- Local officials meeting conducted -- November 27, 2017
- Public involvement meeting -- December 18, 2017
- Complete the environmental process -- January 2018
- Complete preliminary plans -- February 2018
- Complete final plans -- April 2019
- Conduct a construction information meeting -- prior to the start of construction
- Construction currently scheduled to begin -- early summer 2020
- Construction completion -- early fall 2020
