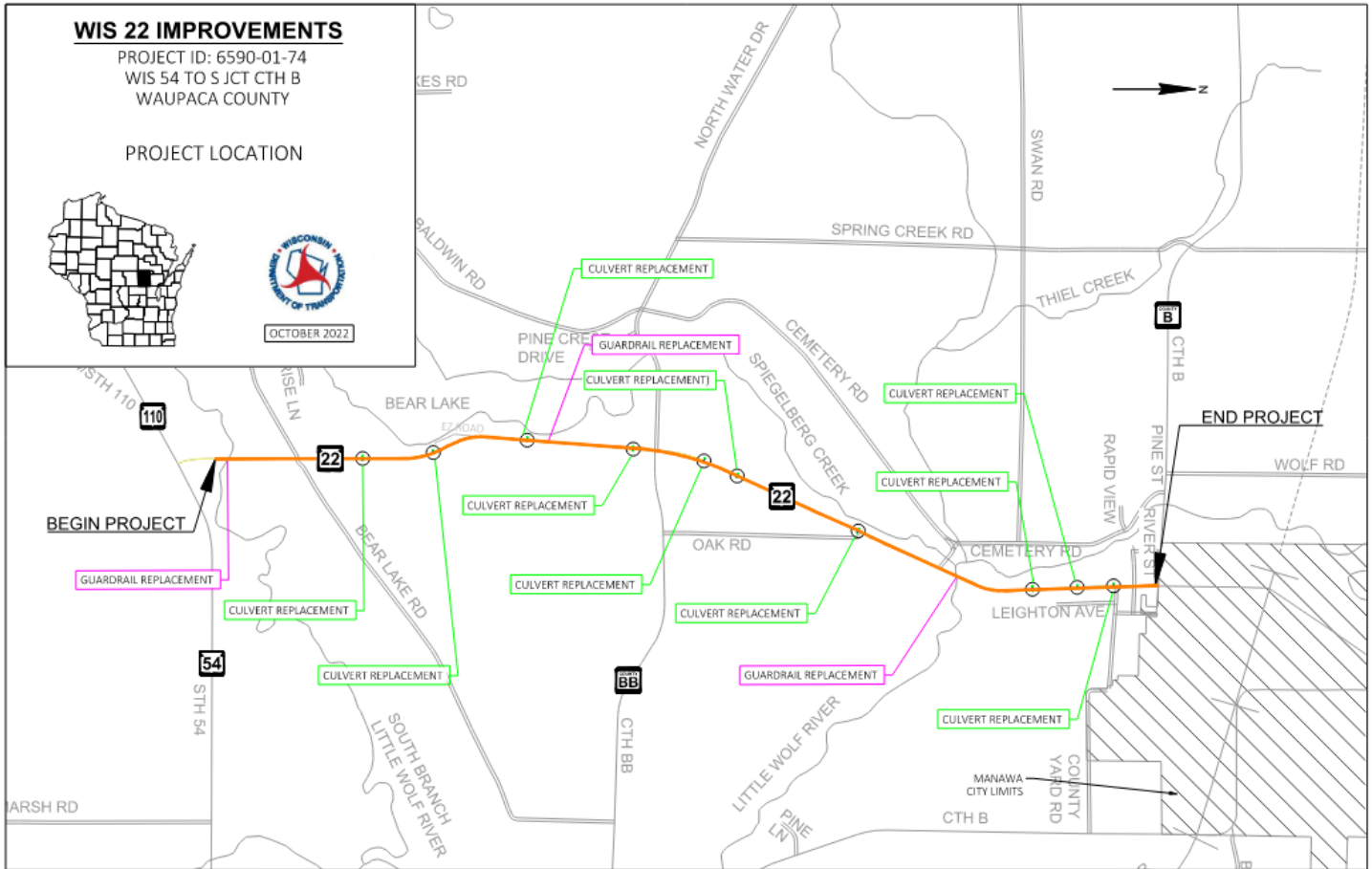

Purpose

The purpose of public involvement is to present design concepts for the proposed improvements along WIS 22, address impacts to traffic during construction and to obtain your input.



Project Information

The purpose of the project is to address the existing asphalt pavement which is exhibiting various forms of cracking. Also, several culverts underneath WIS 22 are deteriorating and in need of repair, and the existing guardrail does not meet current standards.

Proposed improvements include:

- Replace 10 deteriorated culverts under WIS 22
- Remove 4-inches of the existing asphalt pavement
- Place 4-inches of new asphalt pavement
- Upgrade guardrail to meet current standards

An environmental document is being prepared to address potential impacts to environmental resources along the project corridor.

Proposed Traffic Impacts

Construction is currently scheduled for the summer of 2026.

During construction, WIS 22 will remain open to traffic using flagging operations. Staged construction or short-term closures at intersections may be necessary. Motorists can expect some delays to occur, but delays will be managed through limiting contractor operations at critical times. Access to residences and businesses will be maintained except for short periods while construction operations are directly adjacent to the entrances.

Real Estate

Minor areas of temporary easements may be required to accommodate grading in areas of guardrail upgrades and pipe culvert replacements. If required, WisDOT expects to begin real estate acquisition in the summer of 2023.
